



America Is Going All-In for the Kosher Poker Tour

For events held in areas that have Charitable Gaming, Kosher Poker Tour Event follow the regulations for each specific state (California, Louisiana, etc.)

In the other states, the KPT implements our approved non-gambling structure. This structure has been approved for use in all other jurisdictions.

There is no buy-in required to participate in any non-gambling Kosher Poker Tour event. Eliminating the requirement of a Buy-In renders the tournament as non-gambling and therefore it is legal.

1. Non-gambling tournaments do not require a buy in. Anyone that wants to play for free may do so. Therefore there is no consideration.
2. Participants never risk any money, credit, deposit or other thing of value for gain.
3. Chips have no cash value and as such, cannot be cashed in at any time whatsoever.
4. There are no cash prizes at any Kosher Poker Tour event.

Patrons wishing to play for free are given the opportunity and free registration instructions as well as the notice that we do not require a buy-in to participate are included in our Terms & Conditions that all participants must acknowledge reading and understanding before they are allowed to register for any Kosher Poker Tour event. In addition, the following disclaimer is incorporated into the Terms and Conditions:

Kosher Poker Tour (KPT) tournaments in non-gambling states are non-gambling events. Sponsorships, Tickets and Donations are made for the sole purpose of supporting the (insert organization name), a nonprofit organization, and are not in any way payment or consideration given solely in exchange for the opportunity to participate in the poker tournament. There is no buy-in required to participate in KPT events. This is a private event to benefit the (insert organization name) that is being held at a private place and is not open to the public. Only ticketed persons will be allowed admittance to the event. Tickets are for event as a whole and not a buy-in for the Poker Tournament. Chips used in the tournament have no cash value and cannot be cashed-in at any time whatsoever. There are no cash prizes whatsoever. To request a free entry, send a 3 inch x 5 inch card on which the requestor has legibly handwritten their First and Last Name, Complete Mailing Address (e.g. Street, City, State, ZIP code), Email Address, and Date of Birth (each, a "Mail-In Registration"). Each Mail-In Registration must be placed in a single separate envelope, and mailed to 848 N. Rainbow Blvd., Suite 282, Las Vegas, NV 89107. Multiple Mail-In Registrations in a single envelope are not acceptable. If multiple Mail-In Registrations are sent in a single envelope only one Mail-In Registration chosen in our sole discretion, will be processed. No metered mail will be accepted. No photocopies, reproductions or facsimiles of the 3 inch x 5 inch card are allowed. The usage of a service to provide the production of the 3 inch x 5 inch card will not be allowed.

Gambling laws can be simple, or enormously complex. Gambling requires three elements: prize, chance and consideration. To render a poker tournament non-gambling one must eliminate one or more of the three elements. The legal team at the Poker Players Alliance (PPA) in Washington DC and several of the most prominent gambling attorneys in the country that have assisted in the development of our non-gambling structure. This structure is legal in all 50 states.
